If you are applying from abroad, please consider the following:

The Society for the Increase of the Ministry (SIM) welcomes your application for our scholarships. While SIM, because of limited resources, cannot promise to fully meet your financial need, we remain aware of the particular expense and hurdles involved in your getting accepted at seminaries and university divinity schools and receiving appropriate financial assistance.

As you fill out your financial form calculating costs for the academic year, please include your travel into the United States/North America and any return travel if planned, as well as any technology upgrades you may find necessary to your coming to study here.

You may also wish to be aware of the timing and process for your entrance visa. A critical part of that process is your being able to attest to your ability to meet *all* expenses involved pursuant to a theological education, academic and living expenses included. The assistance of a SIM scholarship is a partial form of meeting that bar; your university or school may have external scholarships you can apply for as well.
